

# Reynolds Cruises to Title In Forsyth Invitational

Reynolds won six track events, one field event, and placed second in six events to capture the Forsyth Invitational Track Meet last night.

The Demons finished with 114 points, North Forsyth was a distant second with 53 points, Parkland was third with 47, West Forsyth placed fourth with 38½, and East Forsyth rounded out the five team field with 33½ points.

Four new records were established at the meet which was held at North Forsyth.

East Forsyth's Cedric Moser triple-jumped 41 feet, 4½ inches to establish the record for the event. This was the first year that the triple-jump had been held in a city-county meet.

Reynolds' David Mast vaulted 13 feet to break the old pole vault record of 12-4 set by Ted Yates of Parkland. Mast's previous best jump this season had been 7-6.

Joe Jorden of Parkland broke the high jump record by leaping 6 feet 2 inches. The previous record was 5-11.

The West Forsyth 440 relay team improved on Parkland's old mark of 45.1 by nine-tenths of a second. The Titans crossed the finish line in :44.2.

Possibly the best-contested event of the night was the final race — the mile relay. North Forsyth's Wayne Berry was 20 yards behind the second place man on the

last lap when he started his move. He fell short of winning the event by only two-tenths of a second. West overtook Reynolds to win the event in 3:32.1. The Demons finished second in 3:32.2 while North crossed the line in 3:32.3.

Several members of the 1974 track honor roll improved on their seasonal bests. North's Vincent

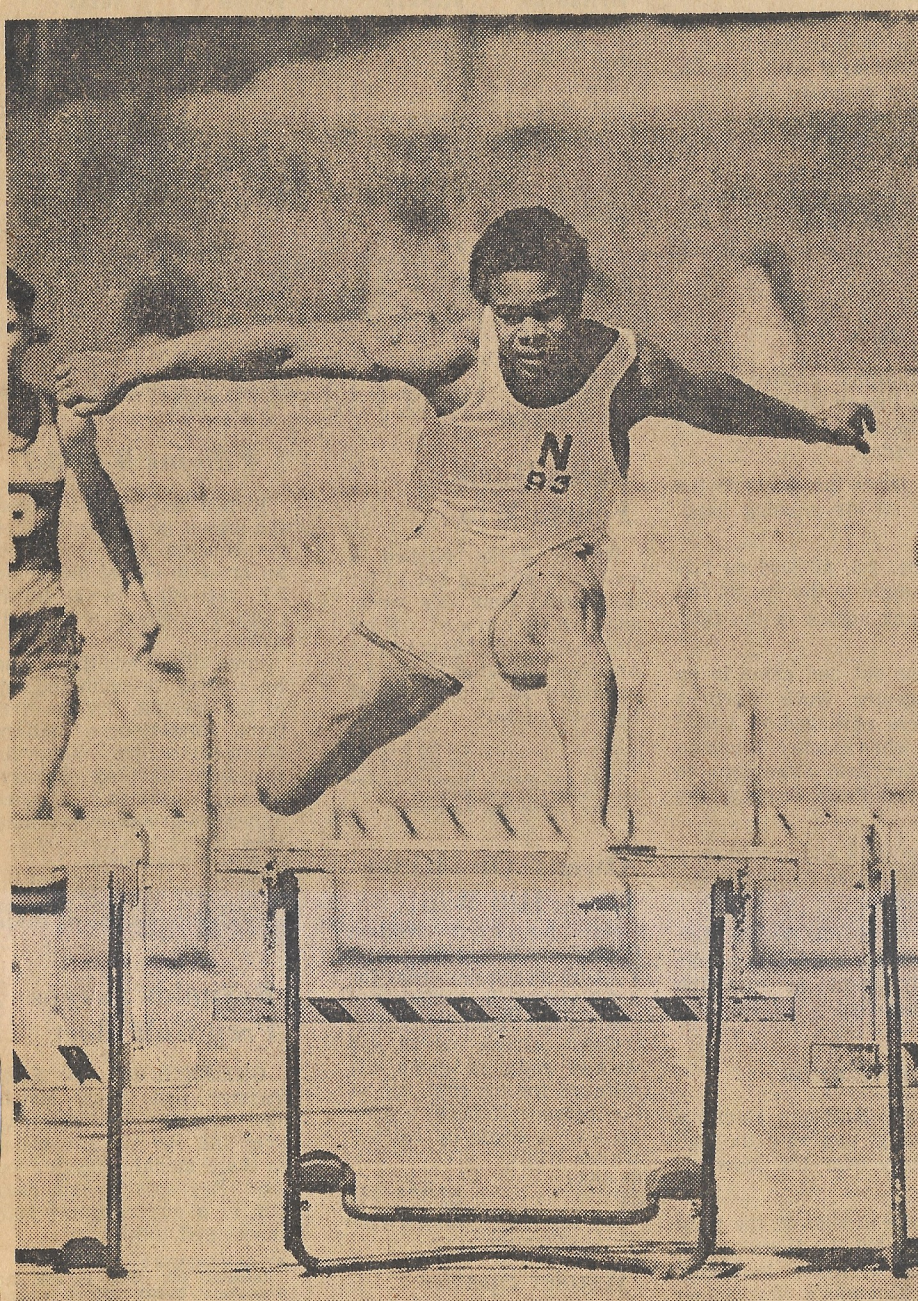

Blackmon tossed the discus 146, feet, 9½ inches bettering his personal mark of 145 feet 6 inches. Steve Shaw of Reynolds improved his 23.1 time in the 220 to 23.0. Another Demon, Robbie Roberts, improved teammate Terry Sullivan's time in the 880 with a clocking of 2:03.7. Sullivan's fastest time had been 2:04.9. Jim Olson, the Demons' two-mile ace, finished the event in 10:10 last night. His fastest time this season had been 10:24.6.

The North 880-relay team took the honor roll lead from Reynolds. The Vikings completed the event in 1:32.9. The Demons' fastest time this season had been 1:34.0.

West Forsyth also took the lead from Reynolds in the mile relay with a time of 3:32.1. Reynolds' best time had been 3:33.1.

The next meet involving city-county teams will be the Central 4-A conference meet on Friday, May 3.

Reynolds will be favored to win the All-Forsyth senior high school track meet at North Forsyth today. But recent improved performances at East Forsyth and Parkland could mean a close meet.

Trials will be held at Hanes Park at 3 p.m. in the sprints and hurdles.

Reynolds and Parkland tied for the title last year.

On the basis of per-

formances during the season, there should not be many records broken. But often track men do better under the stress of close competition.

The high jump could go as Joe Jordan of Parkland has jumped 6 feet, an inch better than the meet record. David Wilson (5-11) of Reynolds and Garry Viet (5-10) of North are top challengers. Alan Caldwell

of East Forsyth (21 feet, 8 inches) and Vincent Pledger of Parkland (21 feet, 7¼ inches) are the favorites in the long jump. Caldwell beat Pledger in a dual meet Tuesday.

David Mast of Reynolds is the pole vault favorite at 12 feet, with Charles Thomas of West (11-6) as the top challenger. Thomas has beaten Mast in dual meet competition.
