1984 KINNEY CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Kinney Cross Country Championships are open to high school students (male and female) who have been running competitively during the 1984 season. They will have an opportunity to compete in one of four regional qualifying meets leading to the National Championships in San Diego, California on Saturday, December 8, 1984.

FINALISTS:

The top eight finishers in each of the male and female races at the qualifying meets will be sent to the finals. Each of these runners will compete in the finals as unattached individuals.

REGIONAL MEET INFORMATION:

The course at all the meets will be 5000 meters (3 miles, 188 yards) and will cover a variety of running surfaces. If the number of entries warrant, two separate races will be run with seeding determined by previous best times.

AWARDS:

Special Kinney Cross Country trophies will be awarded to the male and female champion in each region.

Gold medals will be awarded to the top eight individual finishers in the male and female races in each region. Gold medalists will be honored as the "First Team All Region" and sent to the National Championships.

Silver medals, honoring the "Second Team All Region," will be awarded to the ninth through sixteenth place finishers. The seventeenth through twenty-fourth individual male and female finishers will be awarded bronze medals as "Third Team All Region." Bronze medals will also go to the top 24 finishers in unseeded competition (where applicable).

Interstate competition at each of the four regional meets will also be recognized. The top five individual male and female finishers from a given state will constitute that state's "team." The state's performance will then be scored and awards given to the individuals on the winning and runner-up state teams.

T-SHIRTS:

All competitors will receive competition T-shirts.

Following is a listing of the states in each region:

Northeast

Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont and West Virginia.

South

Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Puerto Rico, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas and Virginia.

Midwest

Arkansas, Colorado, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Dakota and Wisconsin.

West

Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Washington and Wyoming.
