## **THE COURSE**

The course at all meets for both males and females is 5,000 meters (3 miles, 188 yards) and covers a variety of running surfaces. If the number of entries at the regional qualifiers warrants, several races are run with seeding determined by previous best times.

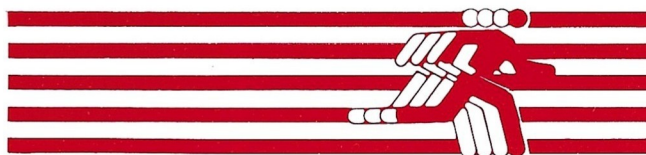

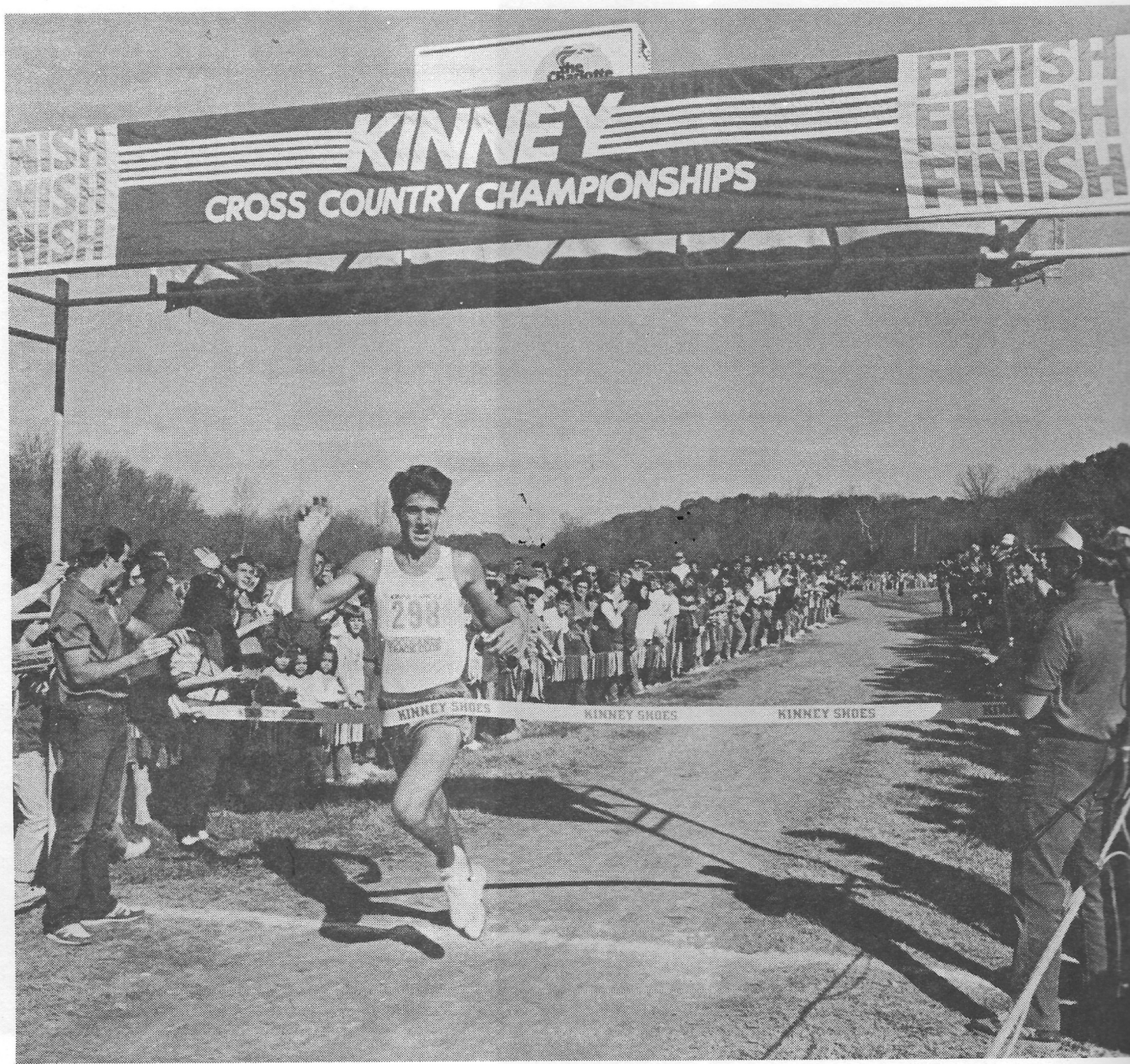

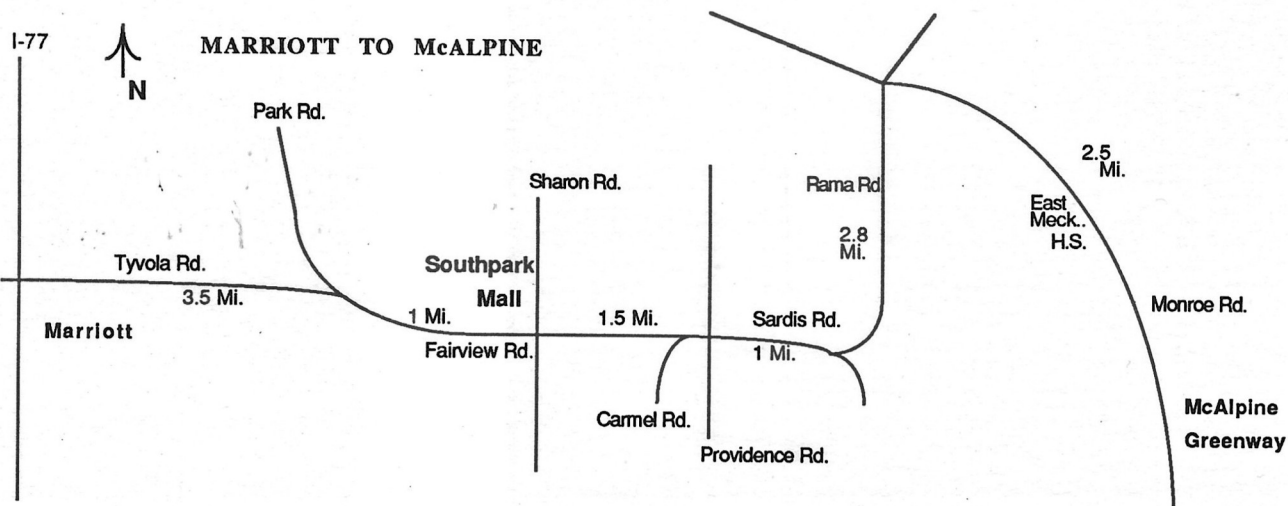




# MEET INSTRUCTIONS AND PROCEDURES

1. Wear the number on the front of your shirt. **DO NOT BEND OR TEAR NUMBER!**
2. Stay in the chute and exit after your runner's number has been entered into the computer at the end of the chute. You will receive an unofficial place card at the end of the chute which will allow you to check your time on the chronomix tape which will be posted after verification of times by meet officials.
3. Your official place and time will be determined by a computerized scoring system.
4. Coaches and parents should be encouraged to stay away from the finish line area.
5. There will be arrows and meet personnel at strategic points on the course to assist you.
6. The course is clearly marked throughout with natural barriers and directional markers.
7. Distance markers are located at each 0.4 km (400 M ).
8. Results and times will be posted on the scoreboards near the finish line. **PLEASE DO NOT OBSTRUCT MEET OFFICIALS IN THIS AREA.**
9. First Aid facilities are available in the finish line area.
10. A lost and found area is also available at the tent in the finish line area.
11. Liquid refreshments are available for the runners in the wooded area near the finish line.
12. The first call will be given by whistle at **ten minutes** before the scheduled start and runners should proceed to the starting line and report to the Clerk at this time. The second call will be given **five minutes** before the start and runners should be assembled at the starting line.
13. Race times will be:
  - Freshman & Sophomore Men - 9:30
  - Freshman & Sophomore Women - 10:00
  - Women's Seeded Race - 10:30
  - Men's Seeded Race - 11:00
  - Men's Unseeded Race - 11:30
14. **AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED AFTER THE LAST RACE!**
15. **PICTURES:** The top 24 finishers in each race are to remain for pictures after the last race.
16. **NATIONAL QUALIFIERS AND 3 ALTERNATES:** Meet with Max Mayo afterwards for instructions about the National Meet in San Diego.
17. **ALTERNATE SITE:** In the event of bad weather, pictures and the awards ceremony will be held in the East Mecklenburg High School gym located 2 miles west of McAlpine Greenway on Monroe Road.

# KINNEY CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS

The world record holder indoors for the mile, 1,500 and 2,000 meter runs. Eamonn holds the record for the mile at every major indoor meet in North America.

Dubbed "The Chairman of the Boards" for his success on the indoor surface, the Irish native managed to capture the inaugural World Championship at 5,000 meters outdoors as well as two fourth place finishes in the Olympic Games.

Still the only man ever to run a sub 3:50 mile indoors, his 1987 season was highlighted by his seventh Wanamaker Mile victory at New York's Millrose Games. That feat wiped out Glen Cunningham's 50 year-old record.

A major force on the international track scene since coming to Villanova University in the mid-70's, he has his sights set on the 1988 Olympic 10,000 meter run.

Previous Kinney spokespeople have included Tony Sandoval, Steve Scott, Sebastian Coe, Ruth Wysocki, Francie Larrieu Smith and Mary Decker Slaney.

## **1987 ALUMNUS OF THE YEAR**

Only in its second year, the Kinney Cross Country Championships Alumnus of the Year award seeks to honor a former finalist of our event who has gone on to make significant contributions to the sport after leaving high school.

The 1987 winner is Lesley Welch. A record setter on the roads and on the track in addition to cross country, Lesley's best finish in the Kinney Nationals was eighth place in 1979. The native of Peabody, MA went on to a distinguished career at Boston University and in 1984 became the first woman in history to win the NCAA and TAC cross country championship in the same year. She was TAC champion again in 1986 and went on to a fifth place finish in the World Cross Country Championships.

The 1986 Alumnus of the Year was Tim Hacker.
