

Perry leads East to win

Pen Perry of East Mecklenburg beat South Mecklenburg's Josh Morgan to lead the Eagles to a win in the cross country meet at McAlpine Park Tuesday.

The Sabres finished in second place with 41 points, behind the Eagles, who had 21. Independence was last in the three-team meet with 73 points.

On the girls side, the Eagles' Mary Van Halmont won the individual title, but South Mecklenburg took the team title by two points.

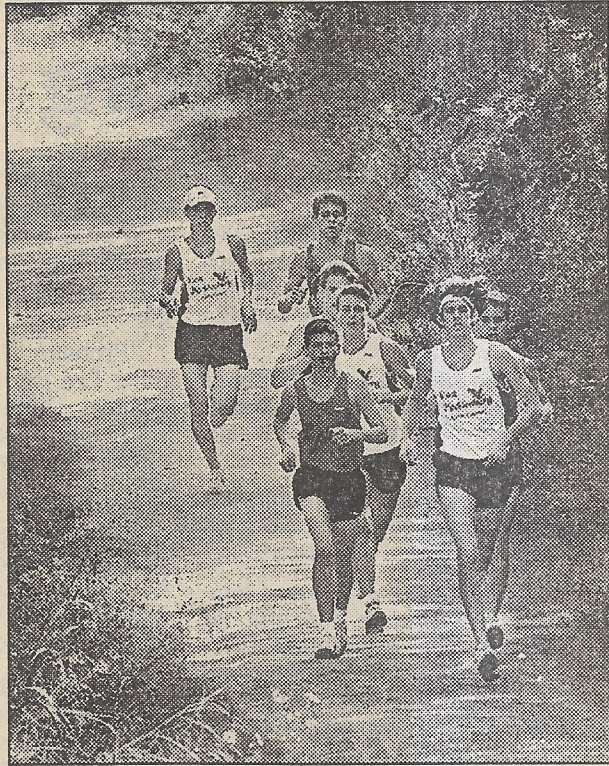
The Sabres won second, third, and fourth places to finish with 30 points. The Patriots rounded out the team scores with 69 points.
