E. Meck boys, N. Meck girls win meet titles

INDIAN TRAIL — East Mecklenburg's boys, propelled by five Top 10 finishers, outdistanced Myers Park by 42 points, 32-74, to capture the Sun Valley High Invitational cross-country meet Saturday.

Natalie Hollar led North Mecklenburg to the girls title as the Vikings held off runner-up Myers

Park 55-78.

"Everything is preseason until conference," East Mecklenburg boys coach Larry McAfee said. "Everything that you're doing is to develop the team and athlete to perform at the optimal level at the end of the season."

While East Mecklenburg ran away with the boys title, two points separated runner-up Myers Park, Sun Valley (75) and South Meck-

lenburg (76).

South Mecklenburg's Josh Morgan ran 16 minutes 27 seconds to capture the individual title by three seconds over East's Pen Peery.

"The first mile I just waited to see how everyone else was running, and I felt comfortable," Morgan said. "And I took off after the leaders."

"(Josh) ran an excellent race," Peery said. "I thought it was going to be Ryan Adams (of Sun Valley) and me, and for the first 2 miles it was. And then after 2 miles he caught up and passed me."

The girls race pitted the top two schools from the MEGA 7 4A — North Mecklenburg and West Mecklenburg — and the top four schools from the Southwestern 4A — Providence, Myers Park, East Mecklenburg and South Mecklen-

With the Vikings winning this time, the race for each team to qualify for the state meet is expected to be competitive.

The top four teams from this region will qualify for the state

meet.

The next meet for most of these schools is The Wendy's Invitational next Saturday at McAlpine Park.
